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Are you a parent/caregiver of a Bloorview outpatient client? Are you a Bloorview outpatient client who is at least 8 years old? Consider participating in our study.

What is this study about:

- This study is one way we are finding out what being involved in outpatient appointments means to clients and families.
- Our goal is to make outpatient appointments at Holland Bloorview the best they can be!
- You're invited to participate because you can tell us what you think about your experiences at your appointments at Holland Bloorview!

Who can participate?

We are looking for . . .

- Bloorview outpatient clients who are 8-18 years old, have a diagnosis, and are receiving Lokomat training
- Bloorview outpatient clients who are 8-18 years old, have a diagnosis, and are receiving group/individual life skills intervention.
- Parents/Caregivers of Bloorview outpatient clients who age 0-18 years, have a diagnosis, and are receiving Occupational Therapy, Physical Therapy/Physiotherapy, or Speech-Language Pathology.

What's involved?

This study runs till December 31, 2019 and involves you answering questions. Different groups of people will have different questions to answer, but all the groups will answer a set of questions that will be a way for them to rate their experiences in their outpatient appointments. These rating questions would be done for each of their appointments and could be done for up to 6 months (or whenever your "on-block"/treatment ends, whichever is first). We think it will take you about 5-15 minutes to answer each set of questions. Your service providers will not know what you have said. You don't have to do this study if you are in the Lokomat study.

What are the benefits of participating?

- Not much is known about what clients and families think about their involvement in their outpatient visits, so you can help us learn more so that we can share that with other researchers and families!
