## Fall 2021 – Registration for swimmers who have a disability

Please note that we continue to monitor and follow COVID-19 recommendations from the provincial and local health authorities. As such, the following changes have been made to our Fall schedule:

- A reduction in class sizes
- Instructors will <u>not</u> be going in the water but will be teaching from on deck
- A parent or caregiver is <u>required</u> to accompany their child in the water if the swimmer is in a <u>Swim Kids 3 level or lower (including preschool levels)</u> in order to provide support for the learner.
- Siblings not registered in the program will not be allowed to enter the building.
- An online self-screening form <u>must</u> be completed prior to every visit to the pool. The completed form will have to be shown to the screeners as you enter the building.
- Whenever possible, arrive with your bathing suit on under your clothes to help restrict the number of people needing to use the change rooms.

In-person registration for Fall swim programs is on **<u>Sunday</u>**, **September 12** in the cafeteria at Holland Bloorview.

Please follow the steps below to register for a Fall program:

- Please return to the previous page and click on the "Enter our Fall Lottery" link before 5:00 p.m.on Tuesday September 7. <u>You must enter the online lottery to receive a</u> <u>lottery number</u>.
- 2. On Wednesday, September 8 your lottery number and related registration time **will be sent to the email address you provided.** If you do not have an email address you will receive a phone call with your lottery number and time.
- Our Fall schedule will be available on this website by August 25. Please return to our online registration page and click on the <u>"Register for our Program"</u> box. Choose "Search" and then click on the level(s) you're looking for to view the Fall class schedule(s) and cost(s). Please check your class selection again after 3:00 p.m. on September 10 to be sure no changes have been made to what you wanted.
- 4. Anyone wishing to register for any of our swim programs must have an online account. Click on the <u>"Register Online"</u> icon to "Create an Account". Enter an adult first and then click on "Create account and add family member" to add your child/ren. Please be sure to check off the two boxes "Periodic emails and mail updates" to receive future communication regarding program information.
- 5. Attend the in-person registration session at your assigned time on <u>Sunday, September</u>. <u>12.</u> Please be prepared to pay for your program (Visa, MasterCard, American Express, cheque (payable to Holland Bloorview), or cash). You will receive a hard copy of a receipt at registration, which you can view and re-print at any time from your online account.

We hope that you can attend the in-person registration, or send someone on your behalf. We may not be able to accommodate requests made after September 15.
