

Social Story: Getting My COVID-19 Vaccine

I get a vaccine to keep myself and the people around me from getting sick from COVID-19.



I go to Holland Bloorview to get my vaccine with my caregiver.



My sibling might come to get the vaccine too. There will be other kids there who will also get the vaccine.



When I get there, I have to clean my hands with hand sanitizer.





I wait my turn in the line.



When we get to the front of the line, I show them who I am to register.



The person at registration will tell me my booth number.



The nurse will ask questions to find out more about me like if I have any allergies.



I will pull up my sleeve so the nurse can wipe down my arm and make sure it's clean.



I will try to sit very still.



My caregiver will stay with me the whole time.



I might feel a pinch when the shot goes in my arm.



The nurse will cover my arm with a band aid and tell me where to sit.



My arm might be sore but I'll feel better soon.



I will sit and wait for 15 minutes.



After 15 minutes, I will get my vaccine certificate before I leave.



I will say goodbye and go home.
