## **PROGRAM DESCRIPTIONS**

#### **Free Play**

Drop in to request an activity you would like to participate in. Options could include; imaginative play, exploration of various toys and activities, arts and crafts, movement, songs, stories and sensory activities.

#### **Snoezelen Room**

The Snoezelen room uses music, lighting effects, gentle vibrations, tactile sensations and aromatherapy to provide opportunities for relaxation and a unique sensory experience. \*Limited capacity – small group visits of 1 – 3 clients

#### **Arts and Crafts**

Art provides opportunity to create, construct, express, plan, and experiment. Join us to explore line, shape, textures, and colours using a variety of materials in our arts and crafts programs.

### **Sensory Play**

Let's let our senses be our guide as we explore the world around us through touching, hearing, smelling, and looking. Activities can include exploration of sensory toys, mixing ingredients for a magic concoction, and following directions for a baking activity.

## **STEAM Activities for Young Explorers**

STEM stands for Science, Technology, Engineering, Art, and Math. Through play-based activities, young children can explore, observe, ask questions, and predict in small structured groups or in individual play. Get ready for building with blocks, experimenting with cause and effect, introduction to technology in play, and mixing recipes!
