Wellness Through Arts Caregiver Workshops

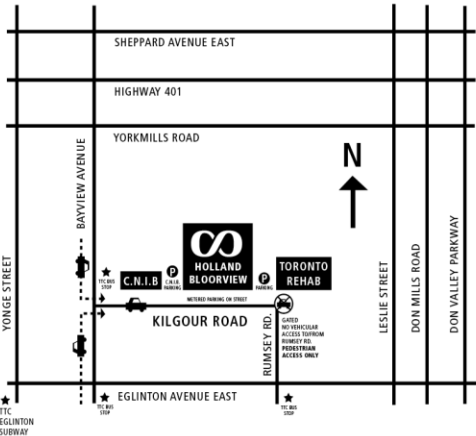
These small group workshops are co-facilitated by an artist and a Family Mentor. Attendees can connect with other caregivers while completing a hands-on art activity.
