*Data is any information about a client like their name, age or height for example.

The client's clinical data is then stored in Holland Bloorview's secure electronic medical record called 'Meditech' to inform their care.


Data Sharing

Data De-Identification



Holland Bloorview removes any personal information about a client like their name so it cannot be traced back to them. This de-identified data is then stored in a separate and secure computer server or 'vault'.
