**What is CP-NET?**

- ❖ CP-NET is network of researchers and clinicians across Ontario focused on transforming the lives of individuals with cerebral palsy (CP) and their families.
- ❖ The CP-NET clinical database is designed to collect information which will help researchers study the causes of CP, improve diagnosis and develop treatments and interventions.

**Who can take part?**

- ❖ Families of children with CP who are 2 years and older, born after January 1<sup>st</sup>, 2009 and who live anywhere in Ontario.

**How do I participate?**

- ❖ Participation may be done remotely by telephone and computer or during a study visit at one of our 4 research sites.
